**Job Goal**: The Driftwood Summer School program provides enrichment to children of the Port Orford-Langlois School District. This position works with students in group or individual learning activities as performed by Summer School Teacher Kinder, 1st-2nd, or 3rd-4th, and planned by the Program Head. Work will include classroom work and preparation.

## **Responsibilities:**

- Instructional support Work with students in group or individual learning activities as planned by the Teacher
- Clerical support Prepare, distribute, collect, process, and store class and student instructional materials as directed by the Teacher
- Plan and communicate effectively with Teachers to achieve student outcomes
- Support the Teacher in maintaining a classroom environment that is conducive to learning, and that guides and supports the transition into the next grade level
- Support Teachers in managing student behavior to provide a safe learning environment, in a way that supports the transition into the K-12 school system
- Job duties may also include bus monitor and/or assisting with breakfast and lunch
