Position: Ready, Set, Learn Summer School, Kindergarten Teacher

Job Goal: The Driftwood Summer School program provides enrichment to children of the Port Orford-Langlois School District. Work will include: classroom planning, teaching, and management during summer 2025. Class hours are 8 am to 1 pm, Monday - Thursday. Additional hours for planning set up, and take down will also be scheduled, including pre-planning sessions during the school year.

Responsibilities:

• Ensure that all classroom lessons are taught using the curriculum as agreed upon with the Summer Coordinator

• Follow the classroom schedule. Ensure that Instructional Assistants follow the classroom schedule as agreed on with the Summer Coordinator

• Translate lesson plans into learning experiences, using the designated curriculum. Teachers will need to adjust classroom activities to facilitate participation

Qualifications and/or Requirements (include):

- Current Oregon Teaching License in Early Childhood Education
- Experience working with children 3-6 and/ or 6-8 years of age

• Maintain confidential records such as attendance, student observations, and parent communications

- Provide direction to Instructional Assistant(s). Plan and communicate effectively with Instructional Assistant(s) to achieve student outcomes
- Maintain a positive and safe classroom environment that is conducive to learning, and that guides and supports the transition into the next grade level
- Follow grant requirements lined out by the Summer Coordinator and Administration
- Knowledge of instructional theory and best practices for children 3-6 and/or 6-9 years of age
- Skills in planning and implementing appropriate curriculum and assisting students in realizing success
